COVID-19 Management at Qihua

30 March 2020

Dear parents,

In light of the developing COVID-19 situation in Singapore, we have put in place strict precautionary measures over the past two months to keep our school a safe environment for our students, and to allow our students to continue learning.

School Dismissal

With the recent spike in imported cases and the tightening of nationwide safe distancing efforts, we are further enhancing precautionary measures by reducing transient congestion during school dismissal.

Please refer to the schedule below on the school's staggered dismissal timing (please allow for about 5 minutes for students to move from classrooms to the school gates)

We appeal to all parents to maintain social distancing of at least 1 metre while waiting for your child in / outside the school. For parents waiting outside the school gates, please wait by the side of the covered walkway to allow students to be able to walk through. If your P4 – P6 child is crossing the road to go home, we appeal for parents to wait at the void decks of Blk 875 or Blk 822 across the road, instead of the walkway outside the school.

Home-Based Learning (HBL) on 1 April

From April 2020, all MOE schools will implement one day of Home-Based Learning (HBL) a week. This will help us prepare for an extended period of HBL should the need arise, so that our students can continue with their learning. Our school will be conducting HBL on Wednesdays from 1 Apr 2020 (Wed). In the event that the day of HBL falls on a public holiday, your child will not need to make up for HBL on another day. Classroom lessons will still proceed as usual on the other days of the week.



Monitoring of HBL

We strongly encourage students to start the HBL by 10am and to complete the HBL by 4pm. The teachers will be monitoring participation rate and will follow up with phone calls after 4pm if students have not started on the HBL. For each HBL day, the form teacher will call some students to monitor their well-being.

Please do email the subject teachers if you have any queries or need further explanations / clarifications on the lesson content / assignments. You teachers will try to respond to you within the day. For queries received after 4pm, it will be responded on the following day.

Support for Devices

If your child requires additional support for HBL such as access to digital devices or internet connection, please alert his/her form teacher, who will be able to advise on alternative arrangements.

Home Support for Student Well-being

The learning activities will be designed to allow students to complete them independently. We encourage you to support your child by providing a conducive environment at home. You could do this by:

- Establishing an agreement with your child on managing screen time. We will assign a

- Encouraging your child to maintain an optimistic and positive outlook while accepting the changes and emotions that he/she has had to face as part of going through HBL.

On the day of HBL, please ensure that your child stays at home and continues to observe good hygiene practices such as taking daily temperature and washing their hands frequently with soap. If he/she feels unwell, please seek medical attention

Suspension of Programmes

Co-Curricular Activities will remain suspended for the rest of Term 2. External activities and those that involve mingling of students across schools – Learning Journeys, outdoor learning activities at the Outdoor Adventure Learning Centres and the National School Games – will also remain suspended for the rest of Term 2. The Singapore Youth Festival Arts Presentation will be cancelled. P6 Supplementary / Remedial Classes, as well as S4 Programme will be suspended too.

MOE is monitoring the situation closely and we will update you should there be any changes to the precautionary measures that we are implementing. We urge parents to rely on official sources of information and not to circulate any unconfirmed information.
