Dear Parents/Guardians of Primary 3 Students

Welcome back to Term 3 © We hope that you and the children have has a meaningful and restful break. This letter will provide more information with regard to Term 3 activities for the level.

### A. Safe Management Measures

The school has sent a Term 3 School Reopening circular via Parents Gateway. MOE has also sent updates on student's absences policies through PG.

Please refer to both documents for more details on Safe Management Measures taken to ensure schools remain a safe place for all staff and students.

### B. Dismissal from School

The school has put in place safe distancing measures during dismissal. This can only be successful with the help of all parents/guardians. **The dismissal plan remains unchanged from previous practice.** 

- The school will practise staggered dismissals to avoid congestion at the school gates.
- We strongly appeal to parents to come to school at the staggered timing indicated in the plan and to wait across the road at Blk 822 or Blk 875.
- Lines have also been marked outside the school gates and at the waiting area next to the security post. We appeal to parents / caregivers to practise safe distancing while waiting for the children.

For parents who drive, we hope to role model good traffic etiquette by not obstructing traffic when fetching your child.

## C. After-School Programmes and Activities

The school will cautiously resume after-school programmes and activities under the guidance of MOE. Priority will be given to programmes and activities that are part of the national curriculum. Safe management measures will continue to be enforced even with the resumption of these activities.



#### F. Assessment
