Dear Parents/Guardian of Primary 4 Students,

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B. Health Matters

Given the uncertainties of the health situation, we appeal to parents to continue to remind the students on the importance of the safety measures that is necessary to keep everyone safe. It is very important not to let our guard down and continue to diligently observe the following. Your co-operation is crucial and is very much appreciated.

a) Students should come to school **only** if:

- They are feeling well.
- They are not placed on Home Quarantine Order (HQO), Stay Home Notice (SHN), Leave of Absence (LOA) or Approved Absence (AA).
- No one above 6 years old in the same household have flu-like symptoms.

b) Wear a Face Mask / Face Shield when they leave their house. **Please help your child manage this better by having an extra mask in their school bags in case they forget or their masks get soiled or spoilt.**

c) **Wash** their hands as soon as they reach school.

d) **Stay** in their assigned seats during lessons and in the canteen.

e) Observe the **staggered** dismissal plan designed to minimise different cohort interactions at the gates and on the road.

C. EAGLETS Days for Primary 1 to Primary 5 Students

To promote self-directed learning through the use of ICT, the school will be conducting Home Based Learning on the days of PSLE Written Examination from 30 September to 6 October and on PSLE Marking Days. Primary 1 to Primary 5 students will be having home based learning on the dates stated below.

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D. Absences and Late Coming

Students who attend school regularly are more likely to adjust better and do well in school. Irregular attendance will affect a child as he/she may not be able to keep up with daily lessons and assignments. Should your child/ward be unwell, do consult a doctor and hand in the medical certificate to the teacher on the day when he/she returns to school. Do note that any absences that are not covered with a medical certificate or categorised under 'Approved Absences' will be recorded as absence with no valid reason.

Students are also reminded to report punctually by 7.25 a.m. every day. We would like to seek your partnership in instilling in our students the value of punctuality as it is a life skill. Punctuality also reduces anxiety and helps a child feel good to start the day. Do note that should your child/ward be late for at least five times, he/she will receive a notice which may result in more serious consequences if your child/ward persists to be late subsequently.
